

SMART FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY PROGRAM MANAGERS

The SMART Health and Safety Program was designed to help industrial hygienists and health and safety program managers operate their compliance programs more effectively and satisfy OSHA employee record keeping requirements.

The SMART System maintains all employee health and safety information for easy access, updating and retrieval. It also enables managers to easily record and update their chemical inventories electronically, while storing chemical safety information.

The system reduces the risk of regulatory fines and citations by:

- ✓ Maintaining all employee training, exposure monitoring, medical surveillance records
- ✓ Ensuring all worker certifications stay current by alerting the Program Manager when action is needed or certifications are expired
- ✓ Ensuring only properly trained and certified personnel are assigned to hazardous materials projects
- ✓ Ensuring agency notifications are properly prepared and accurate
- ✓ Ensuring all required MSDS's are available

The system saves organizations time and money by:

- ✓ Providing accurate records regarding the quantity and locations of hazardous materials so inventories can be searched before more materials are ordered, saving on both material costs and disposal fees.
- ✓ Reducing the number of staff required to maintain chemical inventory information and records
- ✓ Reducing the cost of storing records, many of which need to be maintained for 30 years to meet OSHA requirements

The SMART Employee Recordkeeper stores all OSHA required employee health and safety records including; employee training, medical surveillance, respirator issuance and fit testing, and exposure monitoring records. It also has a critical date's reminder system that informs program managers when events that need to be performed on a periodic basis are 30 days from expiration or past due.

The SMART Exposure Monitoring Recordkeeper stores and manages all OSHA required industrial hygiene exposure monitoring results for any type of sample or constituent. The system also stores a library of OSHA established exposure limits to ensure appropriate personal protective equipment is being used on every project.

The SMART Hazardous Material Inventory Manager enables Program Managers to record and maintain hazardous material inventories and MSDS information to meet Federal OSHA Hazardous Communication and Sara Title III requirements. The system records the key safety and health information for each type of hazardous material used at the facilities and tracks the quantities and

locations of materials. The system allows users to store waste manifest records including the names of the haulers and landfills along with a breakdown of quantities and chemicals.
